

# VIDEOSTREAMING



## HOW CAN IT WORK FOR YOU?



Videostreaming is a great platform that you can utilise no matter what delivery method you currently use. It is a free teaching tool that is limited only by your imagination. The staff from eLearning Services and in your Region can help you develop effective resources that can be used for not only your current student group, but if relevant, students for years to come. Below are just some of the ways streaming can be incorporated into your delivery. For more ideas please visit the website below or contact us on the details at the bottom of the page.

### Online students

As streaming is an online resource, it will fit right in with how your students are already studying. You can deliver streams with course content, such as how to communicate effectively or occupational health and safety, or learning support streams such as orientations to the Region, to Connect, to the course, or to your team. You can use the stream to do a mini assessment by incorporating the e-mail function Mediasite, or poll your students to gain an idea of their understanding.

### Distance students

Streaming can be used to eliminate the isolation factor felt by distance students. While they may not be able to interact with you, even seeing a short video of you introducing yourself and letting them know how to best contact you can help them feel connected. You can record a guest speaker or topic expert that remote students may not have access to, or record a demonstration so that they can see how a task should be done.

### Face to face students

Most teachers feel that streaming is only relevant for online or distance students, however it can also be a great revision tool for your face to face students. Short streams on a topic area that students can watch when they go home to reiterate their learning can help come assessment time. You can also record a stream reminding students of the assessment procedure, or even a study skills video with tips on getting the most out of their learning.

### How can the streams be accessed?

There are a number of ways that your streams can be accessed, but the easiest and most effective way is by inserting the links into our learning management system, Connect. The streams are just like any other link that the students can click on to access resources. Alternatively the links can be e-mailed to students or added to a Word or PDF document. Streams can also be accessed through another website, or put on CD for distribution.

### How much does it cost?

Videostreaming is completely free of charge for all TAFE Queensland staff. There are no production or ongoing storage costs, and your streams will be accessible for as long as they are relevant.
